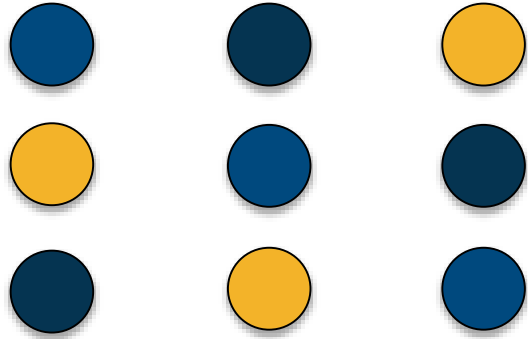
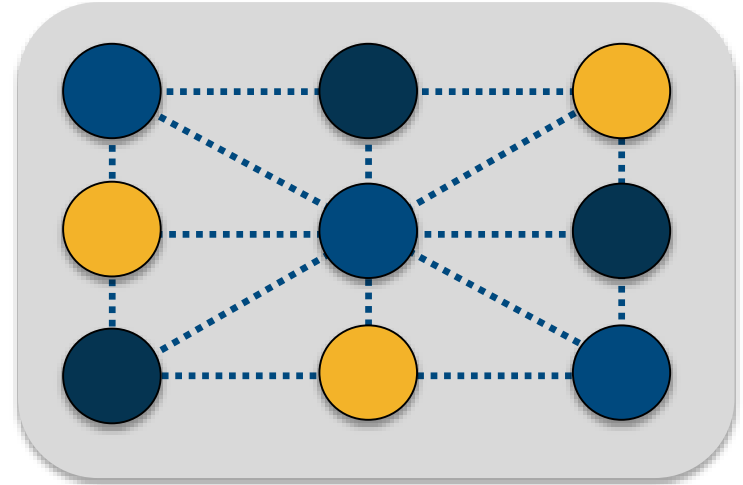




A NEED FOR AN OVERARCHING NETWORK IN CRISIS MANAGEMENT


