## What was the focus of the project?

- To create a **Common European Framework** for the correct and harmonised handling of electronic evidence (collection, preservation, use and exchange of electronic evidence).
- To draft a **Roadmap** outlining strategies, objectives and actions to be taken for realising this Common European Framework.

## What did the project achieve?

- D.F. tools **catalogue**
- **Formal language** for the representation of the Evidence meta data and its exchange: DFAX → UCO/CASE
- D.F. concepts **categorization**: basis for an ontology
- **Road Map** for a harmonised framework on E.E. Treatment and Exchange
